Words with endi	ngs sounding like /ʒə/	/ or /t_ʃə/

The ending sounding like /3 = / is always spelt – sure. The ending sounding like /t = 1 = 0 is often spelt –ture, but check that the word is not a root word ending in (t)ch with an er ending – e.g. *teacher, catcher, richer, stretcher*.
